#### NAMC Teen Volunteer Program Purpose & Qualifications

**Purpose:**

The NAMC Teen Program provides teenage students the opportunity to explore an interest in health careers through direct exposure to health care environments. As a byproduct, students gain the moral satisfaction from constructive community service, thus developing a sense of civic responsibility which is mutually beneficial to the medical community and to the student.

**Qualifications:**

- 14 years of age by May 1<sup>st</sup>
- Completed 8<sup>th</sup> grade by May 31<sup>st</sup>
- Firm commitment to volunteer full sessions.
- Commitment to arrive on time and stay until end of shift (unless prior approval has been given).

#### Overview

<b>Deadline</b>	Applications (including recommendations and photo) must be received by Volunteer Services no later than 5pm May 2 <sup>nd</sup> to be considered for the program.
<b>Submission</b>	Submit Completed applications in one of the following ways: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Email to <a href="mailto:renee.haney@namccares.com">renee.haney@namccares.com</a>.</li><li>• Drop off packet in sealed large envelope at the Volunteer Services Office.</li></ul>
<b>Acceptance</b>	Volunteer Services will send an acceptance letter (by 4pm May 20th) via <b>email</b> to the selected applicants and their parent/guardian. A prompt response (no later than 4pm May 27th) is required to confirm a place in the TVP. This letter will include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Volunteer Schedule (chosen by the student during application process)</li><li>• Orientation Information (date, location, direction, dress code, etc.)</li><li>• Forms and Required Documents (to be signed and returned at orientation)</li></ul>

<b>Uniform</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Official NAMC teen t-shirt</li> <li>• Khaki colored full length pants or scrub pants if assigned to a clinical area</li> <li>• Closed toe shoes (tennis shoes acceptable)</li> <li>• Name badge- provided by Volunteer Services</li> </ul>
<b>Orientation</b>	<p>Mandatory orientation is held in a group setting. The Volunteer Coordinator will review the program manual, answer questions, provide assigned stations, and provide shirts/badges. Lunch will be provided at orientation. Wear comfortable closed-toe shoes for a walking tour of the medical center.</p>
<b>Immunizations</b>	<p>Accepted TV's will need to provide proof of current MMR, TDap, Varicella, and COVID-19 vaccinations. They will also be required to get a one-step TB test which will be conducted at the NAMC Employee Health office. More info will be included in acceptance packets.</p>
<b>Placement</b>	<p>We cannot guarantee placement in specific areas and some departments will only take one volunteer. We ask that you be willing to serve in all areas of NAMC. Please be aware that volunteering is NOT shadowing. Volunteering means providing selfless service to an organization.</p>
<b>Commitment</b>	<p>This is highly competitive and for every student accepted there are two that are not. Now is the time to discuss family commitments including summer vacation and other events that may be a scheduling conflict. An honest and realistic look at the ability to firmly commit.</p>
<b>Important Dates</b>	<p>Orientation: June 3<sup>rd</sup> from 12pm-3pm</p> <p>Volunteer Session: June 6<sup>th</sup>- July 22<sup>nd</sup></p>
